We have been notified by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (ACOE) that the initial field work in its environmental study on RCA Common Property, between North Entry Rd and Sumac Dr, is estimated to be completed between 3/29 – 4/16. These areas will be marked for underground utilities, and soil/water samples will then be collected. A crew from Bluestone Environmental will be onsite with pick-up trucks and a small skid-steer.

With the unusually warm weather this week, we have had a number of inquiries about the sale of paper yard waste bags. We will not be selling them in the office, but Village Ace Hardware is again offering a discount to Radisson residents. Coupons will be in Reflections throughout the season.
