#### **Town of Lysander Parking Ordinance**

Section 1: PROHIBITION OF ALL NIGHT PARKING No vehicle shall be parked on any public highway within the Town of Lysander between the hours of 2 AM

and 7 AM during the period BEGINNING NOVEMBER 1 and ENDING APRIL 15 of each year. Section 2: It is a traffic infraction for a person to violate any of the provisions of this ordinance. Every person convicted shall for a first conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than fifty dollars; for the second such conviction within eighteen months thereafter, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars, upon a third or subsequent conviction within eighteen

months after the first conviction, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than two hundred fifty dollars.
