RCA offers Assessment Payment Options to suit everyone!

1. ACH/Automatic Withdrawal. We do the work and your payments are always on time. Quarterly payments can be automatically deducted from your bank account by RCA. Simply fill out an ACH form (available on our website or in the office), sign and return it along with a voided check to the RCA office.
2. Pay online using your own bank's payment options. Many institutions will mail a check for you at no charge. Be sure to reference your RCA account number. Please send to: PO Box 105007 Atlanta, GA 30348
3. Pay online using smartstreet.com (now called unionbank).
4. Mail a personal check with the remittance slip to the address on the stub.
5. Check and cash payments are always accepted at the RCA Office. There is a drop box in the office and one outside to the left of the entrance door.

Use any of these methods to pay the entire year's assessment at once. Simply multiply the amount of your April statement by 4; there are no additional fees.

Holiday Decoration Reminder

Holiday decorations must be removed 30 days after the holiday. Since holiday lights in trees and in landscaping can be difficult to remove in our snowy CNY winters, lights can remain in place until April 1st, provided that they are not in use.

Trash & Recycling Tote Storage
