## Seasonal Reminders

### Key Purchases

Several of our amenities are accessible only with a key; the Tennis Courts (\$5), River Park(\$5) and the Boat Launch (\$50). New locks and keys are needed each season for the River Park and Boat Launch. They are updated on or about April 1, so long as the weather is cooperating.

Tennis courts locks and keys are generally kept in place for 3 years at a time. They were updated last in 2016, giving key holders one more season before new keys are needed.

Keys for any of these facilities can be

purchased in the RCA Office. They are also available at the Oberon Pool Office during open swim hours.

### Storage Yard Lots Available

The newly expanded storage yard has several lots still available for large RVs and trailers. Contract details are on our website.

### Community Garden Plots

Contracts for available plots will be available beginning April 1. Plots are \$25 each plus security deposit. Perennial plots will go quickly! Check the website for contracts.
