Please note that some events may require residency, some may require pre-registration, and while many are free, some do involve a fee.

Events and programs are subject to change each year and new ideas are always welcome!



RADISSON COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION

Radisson is a planned community where land use and architectural design are controlled to protect your investment and quality of life.

Living or working in Radisson offers access to an assortment of facilities, parks and open recreational areas. Access to some is restricted to those with confirmed employment at a Radisson business in good standing. All are maintained by the RCA with the exception of the golf course. Please follow the guidelines to using these areas so that they are available for all to enjoy.

COMMON PROPERTY

The common areas and open spaces of Radisson are for the use and enjoyment of all RCA residents and members. These areas are open for use when they are not reserved or otherwise restricted. The RCA Maintenance staff maintains these properties and are the only people authorized to do so.

ASPEN HOUSE COMMUNITY CENTER

The Aspen House Community Center is used for a wide variety of community and RCA activities. It is the home of the Radisson Nursery School, the meeting place of many local Scout groups, Radisson Community Association Board and Committee meetings and RCA recreation activities. It is also available for rent by members for private parties, receptions, etc.



The Aspen House Playground is used by the Radisson Nursery School, residents who rent the Community Center as well as those just enjoying the outdoors.



The large banquet room is perfect for hosting all types of events and is quite popular for graduations, showers, and birthday parties.



A full kitchen is useful for warming items from home or for a catering crew to setup for your party.



COMMUNITY GARDENS

Radisson's Community Garden features both perennial and annual plots for the recreational cultivation of garden botanicals. The annual plots are tilled at the start of each season by RCA Maintenance as early as weather permits. The garden has water service at several locations and the plots are maintained by the residents who rent them. The area is located on Drakes Landing Road, near Glacier Ridge and is easily accessed from Drakes.

VEHICLE STORAGE YARD

For storage of trailers, RVs, boats and the like, the Radisson Community offers an outdoor facility near the Maintenance building at the end of North Entry Road. The area is fenced and locked, though renters are able to enter as needed. Space is limited. The annual fee varies depending on the size of the lot. Contract details are available online.



WALKWAYS

The Radisson Community features over 13 miles of paved pathways through some of the most beautiful nature scenes in Central New York. Our walkways, as marked on the Radisson Community map, are intended for pedestrians, joggers, and bicyclists, with pedestrians given the right-of-way. Leisurely rollerblading and skateboarding are permitted; aggressive skating and ramps are not. Dogs on leash are permitted and it is expected that their waste be removed immediately by the owner.

RIVER PARK BOAT LAUNCH

Enjoy private access to the Seneca River at Radisson's River Park. This unique facility offers peaceful recreation for Radisson families. A shade shelter with tables is great place to picnic. A porta-potty is available (summer only) for your convenience. The area is gated and locked; a seasonal key may be purchased at the RCA Office or at Oberon Pool (summer only).

Our River Park Boat Launch is known as one of the nicest launches in the area. In addition to the launch ramp for trailered boats, there is a separate dock, low to the water, for launching canoes and kayaks. Keys for the launch ramp are also available.



Boaters are asked to make efficient use of their time on the ramp.



For safety reasons, swimming in this area is prohibited as is fishing, sunbathing or picnicing on the dock itself.

SWIMMING POOLS

The Oberon Pool, located at 8650 Carpenter Road, is available for use by RCA members and the family members residing in their household. Verification of Radisson Corporate employment is required. Additional guests, accompanied by the RCA member, are welcome for a nominal fee. Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.

The heated outdoor pool is generally open from Memorial Day through Labor Day. In addition to recreational swim time, we also offer Swim Lessons, Aquatic Programs and Lap Swimming. Member rates apply for paid programs. Hours of operation vary a bit during the season, please see website or call the pool office for details.

The pool office is open seasonally only, 315-303-7229.



COURTS & FIELDS



It is expected that anyone using the ball courts will follow the Rules and Regulations set by the RCA. Courts are considered open ONLY during daylight hours, unless artificially lit. The tennis courts are locked; members may purchase a key at the RCA Office or the Oberon Pool during the summer. Lesson and league information is available during the season.

The ball fields are available for open use, but are also used by other organizations. Reservations are made by contacting the RCA Office and field use must be given up to groups with a reservation.



LAKES & PONDS

Fishing from shore is allowed at all of our lakes and ponds, with a strict "catch and release" policy. However, for safety purposes, there is no swimming, boating, ice skating, or other activity allowed on the water. New York State game and fish regulations also apply.



PARKS, PAVILIONS & PLAYGROUNDS

All fields and parks are maintained by the RCA. Their primary purpose is for the conduct of healthy and beneficial sports activities and recreational programs. Parks are considered open ONLY during daylight hours.

Radisson has several small play areas along the walking trails known as "Tot-Lots." For older children or more extended activity, there are larger playgrounds located at Kerri Hornaday Park and Drakes Landing. Tennis courts, shade shelter, seasonal porta pottys, and basketball courts are also at these locations.

KERRI HORNADAY PARK PAVILION

A covered pavilion at Kerri Park is a popular place for parties, reunions and summer gatherings. Used for RCA Recreation Events, it can also be rented or reserved by RCA members through the RCA Office.

Note: Kerri Park is closed during Summer Playground hours.

SUMMER PLAYGROUND PROGRAM

For five weeks during the summer, the children of Radisson (grades K-7) have the opportunity to play games, do crafts and hang out with friends at our Summer Playground Program. Each day has a different theme and special guests visit regularly! Program hours are 9am-noon.

Registration is required to attend.



RADISSON GREENS GOLF COURSE

The Radisson Greens Golf Course, 8055 Potter Road, is a privately owned, public 18-hole golf course. A championship course, it also offers a fully staffed Pro Shop, lessons and leagues for men, women and juniors, annual events, and more.
